In 2011, he helped create a healthcare membership called VidaPlus which provides access to all the services offered by the clinics at a discount of up to 90%. Since then, Pedro has helped expand the services offered to the underprivileged community which currently includes: Primary Care, Endocrinology, Cardiology, Nutrition and Wellness, Optometry, Behavioral Health, Ultrasound/Cardiac Lab, E/R Diversion Unit, Labs, and now a Pharmacy. Currently, he works as Operations Director and Patient Center Medical Home Director for Darsalud. In this role, he is dedicated to promoting an outcome-oriented healthcare reform that will allow providers all over the country to facilitate access to coordinated quality care to all their patients, regardless of their demographic, income, or insurance status. Some of his other passions include Immigration and Education Reform as well as contributing towards the growth and prosperity of the city of Memphis.
